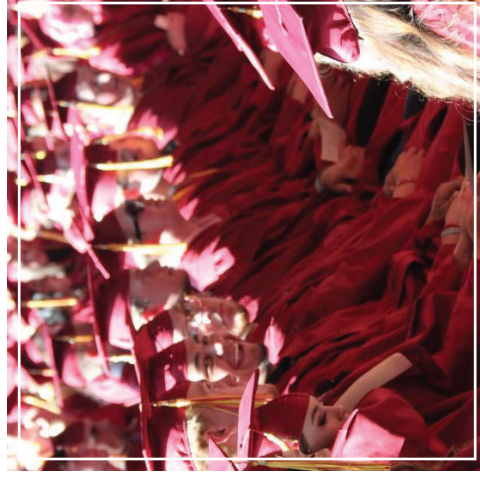
In April & November 2018:

LEVIES & LOCAL EFFORT ASSISTANCE



2019 represents a 48% reduction in levy collection over 2018. Changing levy collection authority at this point presents a hardship on district that recently passed resolutions. Levies are expensive to run (\$73,000 for E.S.D.) and should not be relied upon for basic educational needs.
