

Solution Tree, in partnership with WASA, is entering the second year of a powerful statewide professional learning project. This highly customized, 3-year project is designed for district leadership teams to put systems and processes in place to ensure equity and high levels of learning for all students.

Each year of the project addresses critical components of Professional Learning Communities at Work, and includes virtual workshops led by Solution Tree experts who have implemented these practices both as practitioners and partners with districts. Participating districts are also assigned a Solution Tree expert that will work directly on campus throughout all three years to accelerate and support the systems and processes being implemented.

There are currently two cohorts of Washington school districts participating in this work. Cohort One began during the 2021-2022 school year, and is entering year two of the project, while Cohort Two will begin during the 2022-2023 school year. Cohort Three will kick off in August 2023.
