Washington Sensory Disabilities Services (WSDS) is here to assist children, ages birth to 21 who are:

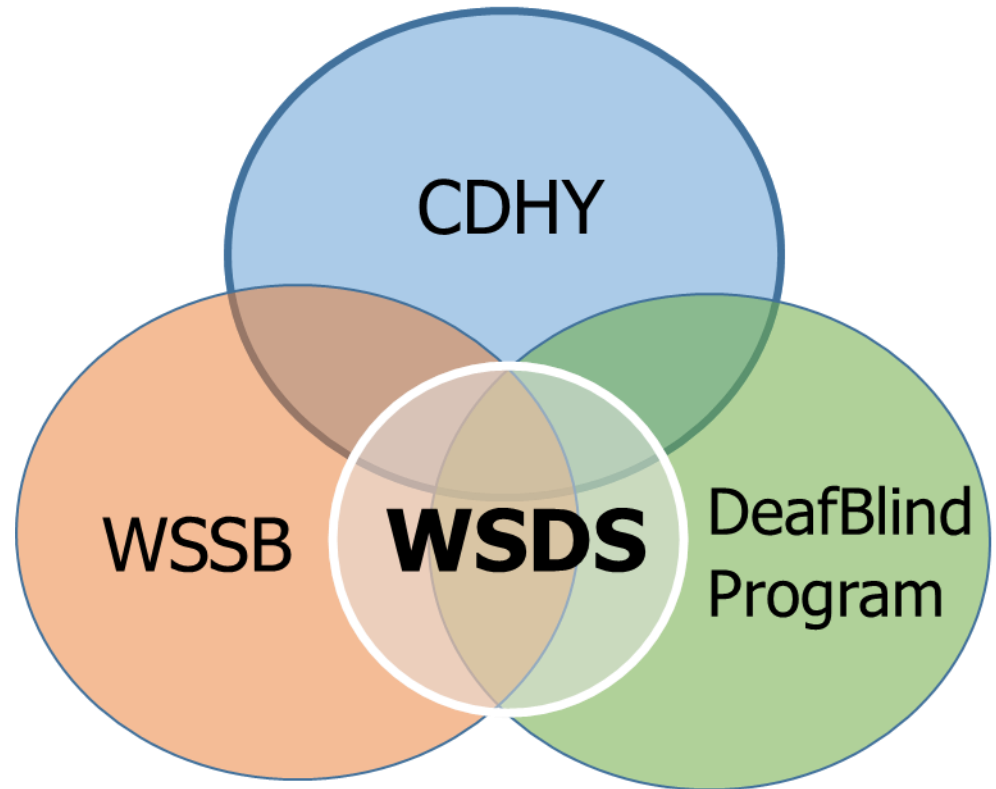
- o Deaf or hard of hearing
