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# State Needs Projects

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OSPI Special Education funds several state needs projects.

These projects collectively provide statewide capacity building through:

- Professional development opportunities
- Technical Assistance, and
- Consultation and training for parents, families, and educators



# The Six Projects

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- ❑ **Center for Change in Transition Services (CCTS)** - CCTS provides secondary transition training and technical support to serve eligible students who are in need of post-school transition services.
- ❑ **eLearning for Educators** - The eLearning for Educators Project provides statewide access to affordable online courses designed to support K-12 educators in serving students with disabilities.
- ❑ **Expanding Capacity for Special Education Leadership (ECSEL)** - This is a collaborative program for special education administrators, originally formed in partnership with the campuses of University of Washington and Washington State University. ECSEL is administered through University of Washington Bothell.
- ❑ **Special Education Technology Center (SETC)** - The SETC provides training, consultation, technology loans and resource information to help school districts and families implement assistive technology (AT) interventions in addressing the learning needs of children with disabilities.
- ❑ **Washington Sensory Disabilities Services (WSDS)** - WSDS supports individuals aged birth to 21 who are deaf, hard of hearing, blind, visually impaired, or deaf-blind, by providing training and other resources to service providers and families.
- ❑ **Special Education Support Center (SESC)** - SESC provides information and best practices through statewide training to families, educators, and organizations in order to meet the needs of students with disabilities.

# eLearning for Educators

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Provides statewide access to affordable online courses designed to support K-12 educators in serving students with disabilities.

- Access course offerings anytime, anywhere;
- Focus on relevant topics in special education; and
- Enhance professional development and earn clock hours.

# Delivery Format

## **eLearning for Educators**

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- Fully online via Canvas learning management system.
- Participants work through content in a variety of formats.
  - Written information
  - Video clips and demonstrations
  - Audio interviews
  - Interactive activities
- Other formats are recorded webinars or online modules with narration.
- Participants complete assignment and quizzes.
