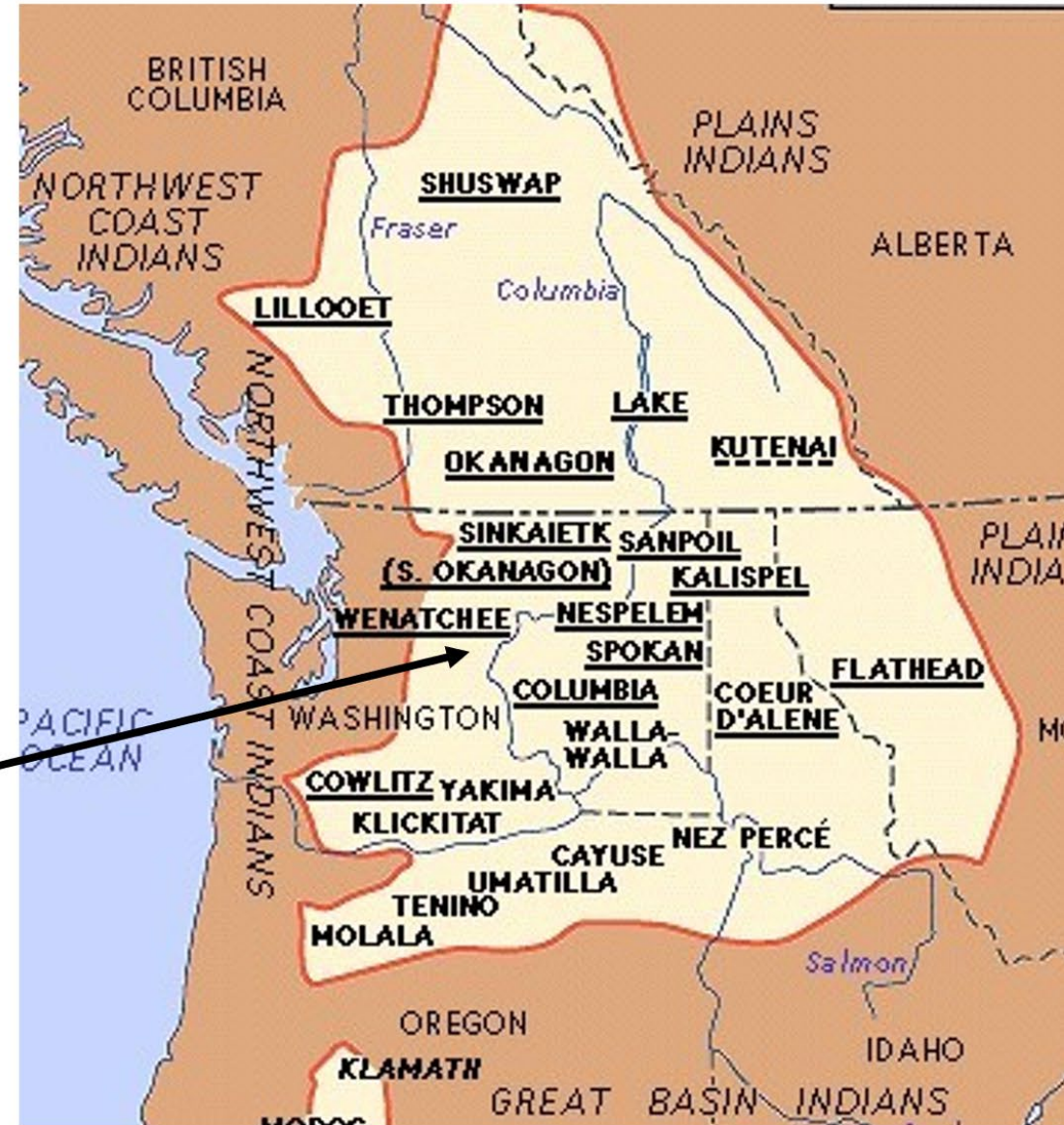

# Land Acknowledgement

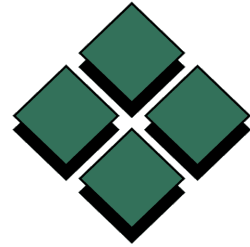
We acknowledge that this meeting is being held on the traditional lands of the Tsillan Tribe, and express our deepest respect and gratitude for their enduring care and protections of the lands and waters here. The Tsillan are one of 12 aboriginal tribes that make up the Confederated Tribes of the Colville.

The Chelan are an Interior Salish people speaking the Wenatchi dialect, though separate from that tribe. The name derives from the traditional Wenatchi name Tsi-Laen meaning “deep water” (pronounced “Chelan”).

We recognize that their story deserves more public and frequent telling within this community.
