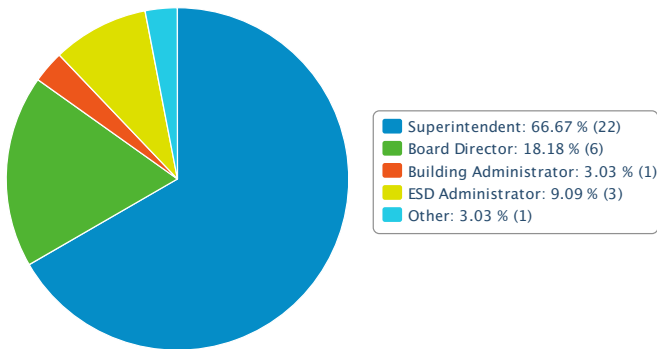

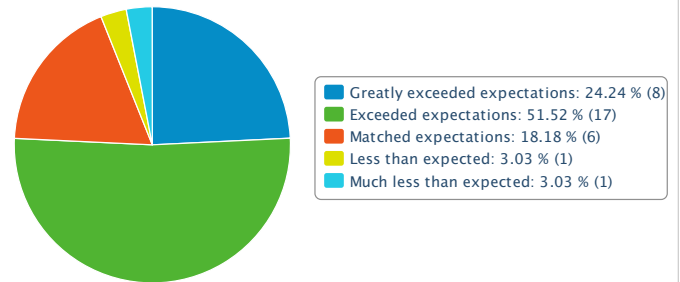

What is your position?



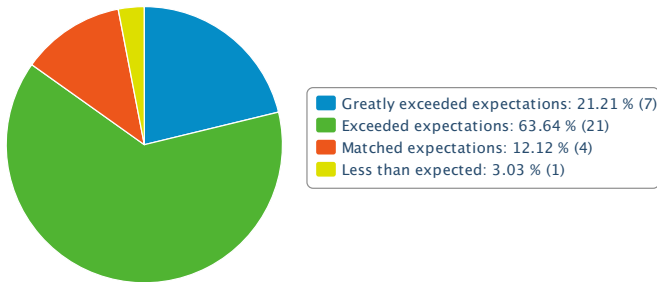

3. Please rate the extent to which school and district improvement efforts have been met.



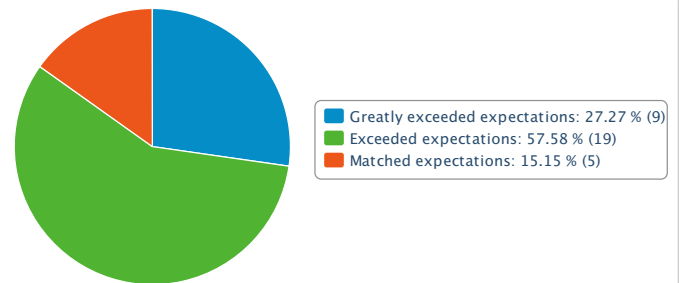

1. Please rate the extent to which the conference objectives have been met.



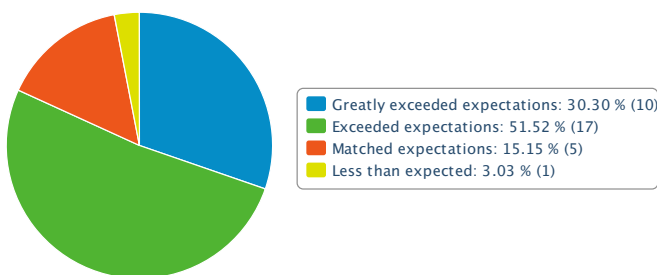
