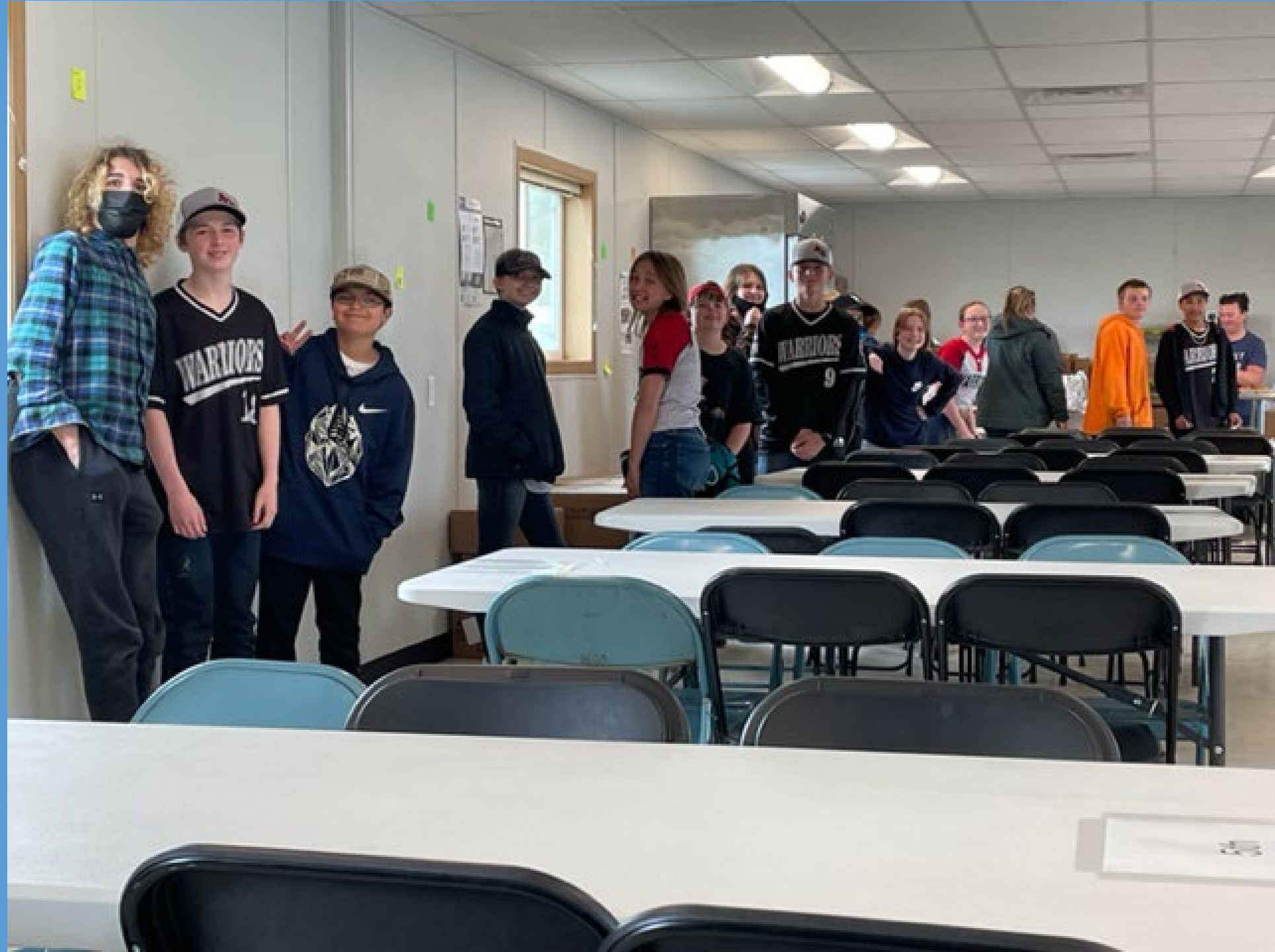

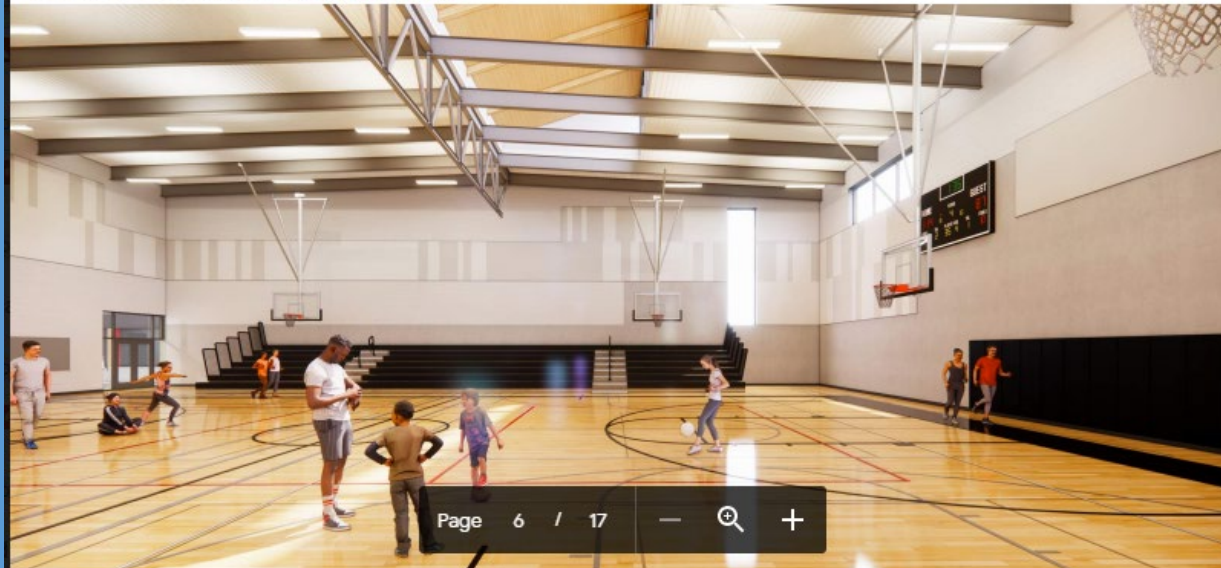

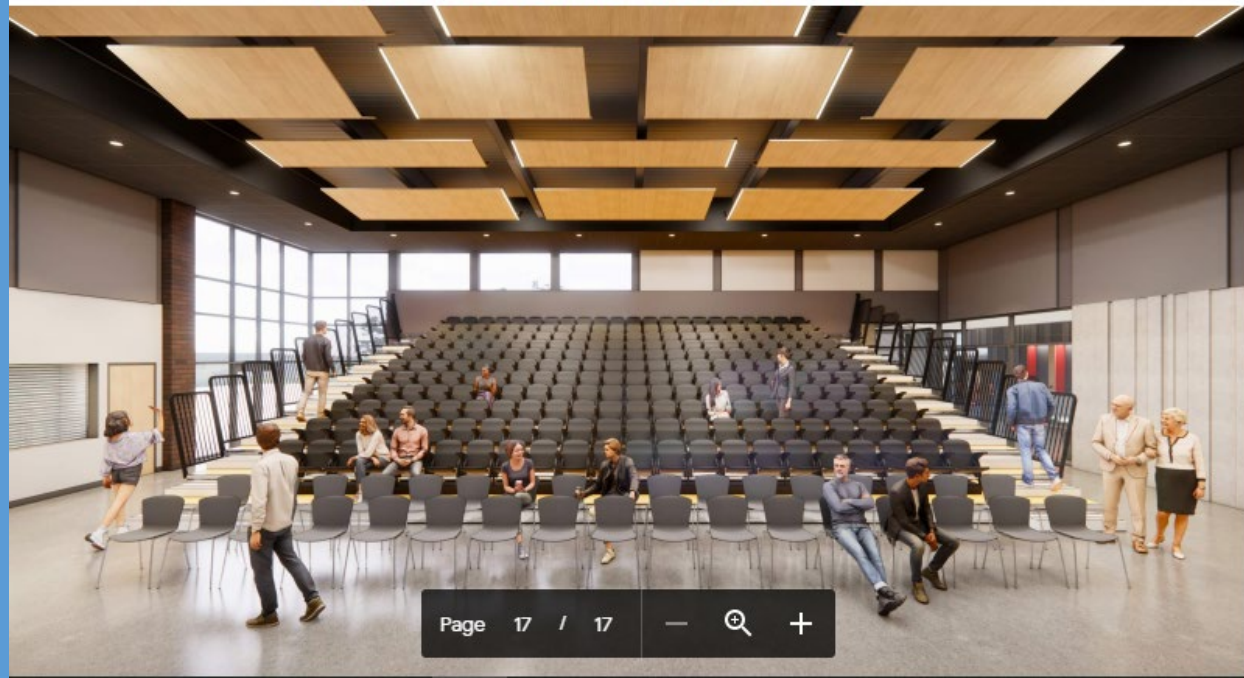

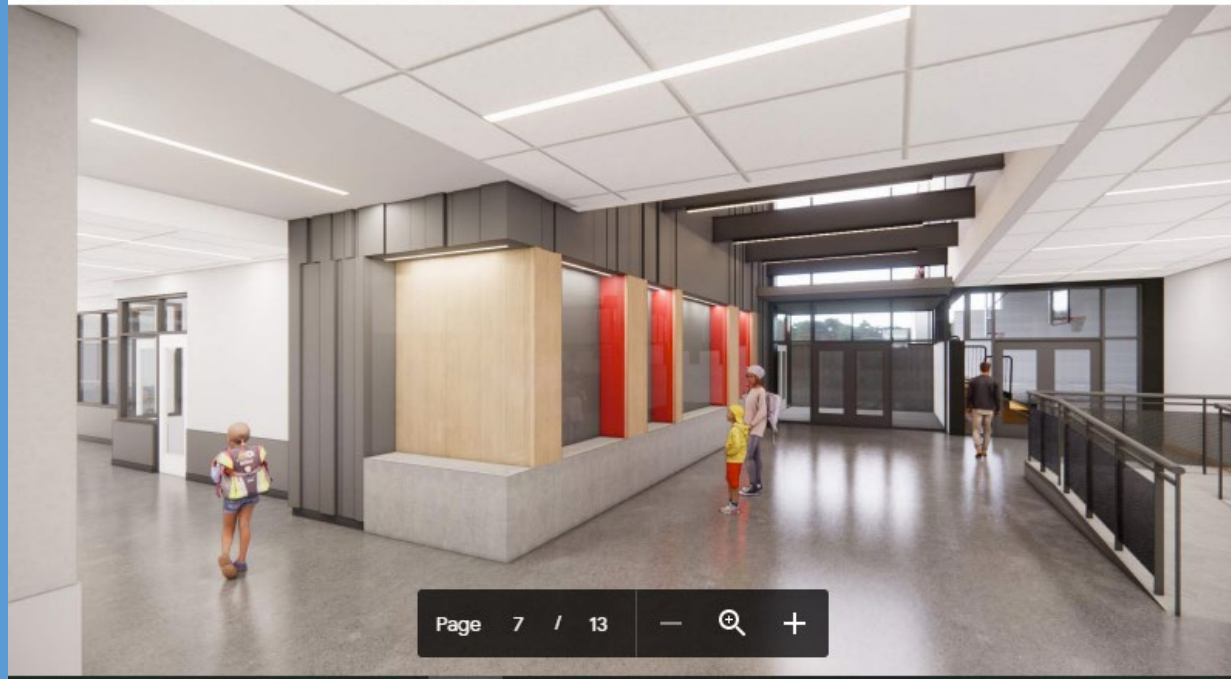


INTERIOR CHARACTER MULTI-PURPOSE ROOM AT PERFORMANCE TIME
